

Refugee Development Center Fall Youth Programs Internship

Duration: August 28th - December 21st Term: 18 weeks Hours: 8-12 hours/week

Description: The mission of the Refugee Development Center is to cultivate a welcoming, thriving community that collaborates with refugees and newcomers through education, engagement, and support. <u>www.refugeedevelopmentcenter.org</u>.

This internship will offer a comprehensive experience in programming at the Refugee Development Center. Interns will be involved in indirect and direct service responsibilities for our Elementary and Youth Mentoring Programs. These Programs help newly arrived refugee families through targeted activities and lessons for all age groups: Elementary, middle school and high school enrichment programming, supporting language acquisition and cultural immersion. This program takes place at a partner location in Lansing and features classroom based lessons in partnership with other organizations and groups that provide arts, music and sports.
