Responsibilities and Duties

- Greet new and returning students
- Complete new student registration
- Keep the Welcome Desk and nametag area clean and organized
- Give out and track student bus passes
- Schedule appointments for navigation services and driving simulator
- Make and serve coffee, tea, and snacks
- Be friendly and welcoming to all RDC students
- Teach RDC students the rules of the Newcomer Center
- Take out trash and recycling, sweep floors, and wash tables
- Take inventory of supplies and materials
- Walk parents from their classroom to the nursery when nursery teachers ask for their assistance
- Follow all operational safety and protocol guidelines
